The Mentor Professional Firefighters Local 1845 will be awarding up to two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to any high school senior (attending school in the city of Mentor) pursuing a career as a Firefighter or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT). Payment will be made directly to the student's fire academy or EMT program after verification of the enrollment is received by The Mentor Professional Firefighters Local 1845 Scholarship Committee.

Application deadline: April 7th, 2025

Rules and Eligibility:

1. Student must be pursuing a career as a Firefighter or EMT or both.
2. Scholastic record showing a GPA of 2.0 or above during Junior and Senior year.
3. Students must demonstrate the following attributes: integrity, dedication, focus on physical fitness, being a team player, and a true passion for helping others.

Instructions:

1. Complete the application form.
2. Provide a copy of your high school transcript.
3. Provide one letter of recommendation (not from a family member) from someone who can confirm your dedication to pursuing this career path.
4. Essay: Provide a typed essay (500-1000 words) answering the question: "Why do you want to pursue a career as a Firefighter / EMT?"
5. Submit completed applications and required materials to Liz Brainard, College and Career Advisor.
